

How to Descale a Kettle

- Half fill the kettle and put on to boil.
- Once boiled, unplug the kettle from the electric mains and remove to a safe location away from children and animals.
- Add food safe descaler (white vinegar is cheaper and just as good) until all the limescale is covered.
- Leave in this condition (overnight if possible).
- When limescale has gone, empty contents and rinse thoroughly with cold water.

If the limescale has not disappeared there are three things to try:

1. Repeat the process.
2. Increase the strength of descaler (less water more chemical/vinegar).
3. Leave longer i.e. weekend instead of overnight.

TIP: We use hot water as that helps the acid work harder and faster to remove the limescale. Cold water will work as well but not as quickly.
